## ASSESSMENT AND PRIORITISING OF PATIENTS

The triage system is an internationally accepted process for prioritising emergency patients based on clinical urgency and not in order of arrival.

## THE TRIAGE CATEGORIES ARE:

RED	Patient is suffering from a life-threatening condition and will receive immediate attention.
ORANGE	Condition is serious and the patient will receive attention after red categorised patients have been stabilised.
YELLOW	Condition is less serious and patient will receive attention after red and/or orange categorised patients.
GREEN	Acute primary-care type conditions. The patient will be attended to as soon as possible.

It is important to note that the appropriate medical support will be available to patients during the waiting period.
